

There is a difference, the word of God makes that clear.

Mark 7:6-9 KJV *He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me. (7) Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men. (8) For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do. (9) And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition.*

Colossians 2:8-9 KJV *Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. (9) For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.*

I John 2:15-16 KJV *Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. (16) For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.*

I hope you understand what you are reading. The traditions of men, the culture, as well as the routine, is not according to God but according to man and the world. Tradition of man has no place with God's salvation.

Salvation is only by the working of God and not by the deeds of any man other than God through Jesus. That is to say no man can save you through what they do for you except for Jesus!

Colossians 2:10-12 KJV *And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power: (11) In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ: (12) Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.*

Ephesians 2:8-9 KJV *For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: (9) **Not of works**, lest any man should boast.*

Romans 10:9-10,13 KJV *That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
