II Corinthians 5:17 KJV Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

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
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
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Do you TRULY love Jesus???

John 3:18-20 KJV He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. (19) And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. (20) For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved.

JESUS SAID...

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DON'T MAKE EXCUSES WHY NOT TO KEEP HIS COMMANDMENTS

I John 5:2-4 KJV By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments. (3) For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

Romans 12:1 KJV I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

I John 1:9 KJV Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son. But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. (4) For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.

DO YOU KEEP THE COMMANDMENTS IN GOD'S WORD? DO YOU ABIDE IN THE DOCTRINE OF CHRIST?

Remember the Ten Commandments? Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not covet or commit adultery...if you hate someone you have committed murder already in your heart (I John 3:15). If you look at someone with lust you have committed adultery with them already in your heart (Matthew 5:28). Consider now the other commandments that are often overlooked...
I Thessalonians 5:22 KJV Abstain from all appearance of evil.
I Thessalonians 5:17 KJV Pray without ceasing.
Romans 12:14 KJV Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not.
Romans 12:18 KJV If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.
Romans 12:21 KJV Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.
Acts 15:29 KJV That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Fare ye well.
