

V. You "ask Jesus into your heart" for salvation

If you believe the gospel of salvation is to simply "ask Jesus into your heart" please show me a chapter and verse where the Bible declares such a thing. You cannot do it because it is not in the Bible...no matter what your Sunday school teacher told you.

Here is what the Bible says about salvation...

Romans 10:9 KJV *That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.*

Ephesians 2:8 KJV *For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.*

Just praying a "sinner's prayer" and asking Jesus to come into your heart will not save you. You must believe that Jesus died and rose again. Then, from a pure and humble heart, call upon the Lord. Any other way of salvation is ANOTHER GOSPEL!

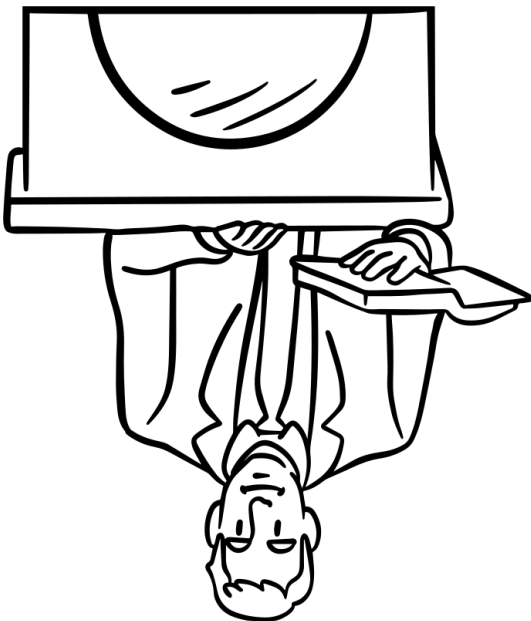

HAVE YOU BEEN LIED TO???



*II Corinthians 11:4 KJV For if he that cometh preacheth **another Jesus**, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.*

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The scriptures warn us of another Jesus, another spirit, and another gospel. If your JESUS is not according to God's word then you have an imposter.

YOU HAVE ANOTHER JESUS IF...

I. Your Jesus is the second person of the "Trinity"

John 5:43 KJV I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.

I John 5:7 KJV For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

James 3:9 KJV Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God.

I Thessalonians 5:23 KJV And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

The verses above tell us that Jesus came in his Father's name...what name did he come in? JESUS! The scriptures tell us that the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost ARE one (not IN one). And that we are made similar to God...we have a spirit, soul, and body. So we know that God also has a Spirit (Holy Ghost), soul (the Father), and body (Jesus Christ). This is what the scriptures teach us. Not that there are separate persons to God. That is ANOTHER JESUS!

Hebrews 1:3 KJV Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person...

II. If your Jesus allows images made of him

Acts 17:29 KJV Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device. 30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

If your Jesus can be painted, drawn, molded, crafted into jewelry, or even made into a pathetic little plastic statue then you have ANOTHER JESUS.

III. Your Jesus "hates the sin but loves the sinner"

Deuteronomy 32:4 KJV He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.

Psalms 5:5 KJV The foolish shall not stand in thy sight: thou hatest all workers of iniquity.

If your Jesus does not judge sin, and you misuse " Judge not, that ye be not judged." out of context (Matthew 7:1) without also reading I Corinthians 5:12 then you have ANOTHER JESUS.

IV. Your Jesus allows different Bible versions

Philippians 2:2 KJV Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.

Jesus commands us to be of one accord, that means one Bible. Having other versions creates doubt in God's word by adding and taking away words. This is the working of ANOTHER JESUS! (reference these passages for more insight:
