# Have You Been Saved?

There is a difference, the word of God makes that clear.

**Mark 7:6-9 KJV** He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me. (7) Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men. (8) For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do. (9) And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition.

**Colossians 2:8-9 KJV** Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. (9) For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

**1 John 2:15-16 KJV** Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. (16) For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

I hope you understand what you are reading. The traditions of men, the religion, as well as the philosophy, is not according to God but according to man and the world. Tradition of man has NO place with God's salvation.

**1 Timothy 2:5 KJV** For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

**Acts 4:10-12 KJV** Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. (11) This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. (12) Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

So are you guilty of holding the religious traditions and commandments of men above the word of God?

## EXAMPLES OF RELIGIOUS TRADITIONS/COMMANDMENTS OF MEN:

If salvation was by a religion...there is only one religion with the commandments of God mentioned in scripture and that is **the Jewish religion**. But since the Jews rejected Jesus and crucified him, God has now brought salvation to the Gentiles (non-Jews) without religion to provoke them to jealousy. So pick up and read the KJV bible, follow God in spirit and in truth, and stop following tradition and teachings of men!!
