Are You A Jew?

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Are you still ignoring Proverbs 18:13 in the Tanakh?

Proverbs 18:13 KJV He that answereth a matter before he heareth it, it is folly and shame unto him.

Have you sincerely heard out the matter concerning the prophesy in Isaiah chapter 53??

Isaiah 53:4 KJV Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. **5** But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Please consider this...

Romans 1:16 KJV For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Romans 3:1 KJV What advantage then hath the Jew? or what profit is there of circumcision? **2** Much every way: chiefly, because that unto them were committed the oracles of God.

The apostle Paul wrote these verses in the New Testament (NT). Does he sound like a self hating Jew or a Jew hater? No.

John 4:22 KJV Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.

This verse was written by John in the NT Gospel. The NT is not against the Jew's, of the seed of Abraham, at all!

The NT was written by Jews under the inspiration of God (II Timothy 3:16), just like the OT/Tanakh. The OT and NT is God's word. The Talmud is NOT.

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Do not be afraid to read the New Testament, a book written by Jews! Jesus Christ is a Jew! Jesus Christ is the Lion of Juda! Jesus Christ is the LORD! Jesus Christ is alive! Jesus Christ is God! Jesus Christ is the Messiah!

John 1:1 KJV In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. **14** And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Jesus Christ, the Messiah, fulfilled this prophecy about 2,000 years ago!

Daniel 9:25 KJV Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks... **26** And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself...

John 19:1 KJV Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged him...**28** After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I thirst. **30** When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

The Messiah has come as prophesied. If you will not look into what the NT says you have to ask yourself why? Are you going to blindly follow what man teaches you? Or will you search out this matter for yourself, not caring what anyone thinks of you. The truth is never afraid of being found out so why don't the Rabbi's allow you to study this?

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
